As the war reaches stalemate in Flanders, the Royal Air Force fails to find the Dunkirk pocket and Germany is able to shift large forces of troops into the seaside city, overwhelming the Allied troops. In order to evacuate the large numbers of men (which exceed 100,000) the Allies have to build "Merci beaucoup, merci beaucoup", an amphibious ship that is able to carry huge numbers of men out to sea. But it is not enough. The SS Normandie is sunk. As the Allies try to escape, ships are sunk, pilots are shot down, and thousands of men die. On the beaches, Allied troops are harassed by the enemy, who does everything in his power to force the men to stay in their trenches and fight a pointless war. There is no glory or heroism in this story, only harsh reality. Thousands of men struggle to survive. Those who find safety on the beach wait as the longboats fill with men. Men are crammed in so tightly that there is little space for even breathing. In the middle of the night, when the air is thick with gas from exploded munitions, some men begin to vomit, then to hallucinate, and then to die. And, although there are heroic deeds on both sides, the film is not about noble sacrifice, but about two nations who are trying to survive the ravages of war. This adaptation (co-written by the directors of Dunkirk) was filmed in two countries: France and Great Britain, which captured the experiences of both of these countries during the war. Dunkirk was also filmed at the actual sites at which this event took place. The film was shot on location at the beach where hundreds of men waited for hours before being allowed to board the French rescue ship, the HMS Reliant, and when the Allied soldiers were finally evacuated from Dunkirk. The film was directed by Christopher Nolan (who later directed Batman Begins and The Dark Knight), who did not credit himself as the director, but gave the credit to the "star, writer and co-editor" of the film, as he was, at the time, the co-editor. On June 10, 2016, the BBC announced that it will broadcast a special airing of Dunkirk on May 24, 2017, with Christopher Nolan serving as an executive producer.
